Display Monitor



Description: The MON-800 Display Monitor is designed to be used with the *CORNELL inform* Wireless Nurse Call System. It is a 20" LCD computer monitor and connects to the main *inform* server computer using the included cables.

Operation: Allows the inform or independent nurse call system user to view, control and interact with their system dashboard. View system calls, notifications, make programming changes and more directly at a central onsite location. It also allows for remote support by our dedicated Technical Support staff.


Mounting: The monitor mounts using the included stand typically near the central computer server (CM-401 or CM-402).

Engineering Specifications: The contractor shall install the CORNELL MON-800 Display Monitor according to the specifications. Requires 120VAC input power. Connects to the computer server (CM-401 or CM-402) using the included cable(s).




MON-800 Connections:

Connect the included 9010-049 cable DVI side to monitor. Connect the included 9010-049 cable VGA side to server. Connect the AC input power cord female end to monitor. Connect the AC input power cord male end to 120VAC outlet.
