

## Area of Rescue Assistance Design Guide 4200 System

This guide will assist you in designing an Area of Rescue System for your facility. The ADA Rescue Assistance System requires a minimum of: (1) Annunciator, (1) Annuciator Enclosure Box, (1) Call Station per zone, (1) Power Supply, and Signage.

1. Number of Call Stations, specify how many of each type. One is required for every required means of egress per ADA Guidelines. (Specify 1-44)

- 6. Signage: Are Signs Specified? Yes No (If yes, specify which one(s) and quantity)

  - \_\_\_\_\_Area Identification Signs (Non-Illuminated)
  - \_\_\_\_\_Left arrow Directional Signs (Non-Illuminated)
  - Right arrow Directional Signs (Non-Illuminated)
  - LED Illuminated single side (Is Battery backup required? )
  - LED Illuminated double side (Is Battery backup required? )
  - \*\*\*Photoluminescent may be used when illuminated exit signs are required
    - Photoluminescent single faced
  - Photoluminescent double faced
